SUBJECT: EMPLOYMENT TRAINING NETWORK SFP

The Employment Development Department (EDD) Workforce Services Branch announces the availability over two years of up to \$900,000 in Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Governor's Discretionary 15 Percent funds and Wagner Peyser funds to continue the operation of the Employment Training Network (ETN). The ETN has operated for 19 years as the vehicle for providing an immediate response resource center to Local Workforce Investment Areas (LWIA) administrative entity staff, One-Stop Career Center operators, community-based organizations, and Local Workforce Investment Boards, under the auspices of the federal WIA. The services to be provided are solely for the benefit of the local level WIA administrators and service providers.

The ETN arranges for consultant services through cooperative agreements. The ETN staff maintain a lending library consisting of instructional materials, audiovisual materials, transparencies, curriculum guides, learning activity packages, project abstracts, reports and studies.

The Solicitation for Proposals (SFP) is open to public, private non-profit and private for-profit organizations. Individuals are not eligible to apply. Proposals must be received by the EDD no later than September 3, 2008 at 3 p.m. Pacific Time. Detailed mailing/delivery instructions are included in the SFP.
