SUBJECT: FORMULA RAPID RESPONSE FUNDING AWARDS

This Information Bulletin announces the formula-based Rapid Response (RR) funding provided to Local Workforce Investment Areas (LWIA) for the period from July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2010. This funding follows the awards formula described in Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Directive WIAD05-18.

The attachment shows the total funding amount for each LWIA in the right hand column titled, "Total PY 09-10 Formula RR Funding with Hold Harmless." These funds should be used to defray the cost of required and allowable Rapid Response activities in response to layoffs, business closures, and natural disasters.

Expenditures for activities described in sections 665.310, 665.320, and 667.262(b) of the federal regulations (20 CFR Part 652) will be reimbursed under the formula Rapid Response grant code. Other activities not described in these sections must be paid with other WIA funds or with non-WIA funds.

The formula Rapid Response funds will be placed in one grant code (540 or 541) in each LWIA's subgrant.
